Suggested read from the NIV version

1. **DEVELOPING A LISTENING & HEARING EAR TO THE VOICE OF GOD**
Psalms 46:10; Nehemiah 1:4; Isaiah 30:21; John 10:3-5; Acts 13:2-3
 - Humbly and sincerely seek God's mercy for being stubborn to His voice
 - Removal of all distraction that keep us from hearing God
 - Increase spiritual alertness to hear God's voice
2. **SELF-REFLECTION & EXAMINATION OF DISTRACTION
KEEPING US FROM HEARING**
Romans 12:1&2; 2 Corin. 13:5-7; Gal. 5:17-23;
 - Self-examination of areas in our lives that prevent us from hearing from God
 - Honest confession for breaking strongholds
 - Pray, repent, and ask for forgiveness for clarity
3. **DIVINE RESTORATION & STRENGTH FOR LFCC**
Deut. 13:4; 2 Corin. 3:16-17; Acts 17:11-12; Heb. 2:1&2
 - Pray for all leadership to hear God's voice and obey
 - Spiritual maturity, commitment, and clarity of focus for all who are a part of the local Body
 - Desire to love the people of God like Christ
 - God's manifested Presence personally & corporately
4. **PRAY FOR DIVINE HEALTH & SAFETY OF OURSELVES, FAMILY, AND NATION.**
Psalms 91; Isaiah 40:29-31; 41:10; Jeremiah 30:17; 1 Peter 2:24; 3 John 1:2
 - Pray for total healing and restoration over our bodies, families, and the world.
 - Pray that our homes, church, schools, and workplaces are COVID-19 Free Zones.
 - Pray that the pandemic will end suddenly
5. **PRAY FOR PEACE, RIGHTEOUSNESS, & JUSTICE IN THE CHURCH AND THE WORLD**
Proverbs 20:23-27; Romans 8:12-14; Eph. 6:10-12
 - Prayer that all our leaders will hear the voice of God and yield (Spiritual, World, National, and Local)
 - Pray against racial injustice and division, hate crimes, acts of violence, etc.
 - Pray for a united Body of Christ, Government, and all humanity to hear from God clearly
